




ENCOURAGING INDIVIDUALS TO WEAR FACE COVERINGS IN PUBLIC SPACES AND IN RETAIL AND COMMERCIAL ESTABLISHMENTS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF PROSPERITY, here assembled on the 28th day of July 2020, that the Prosperity Town Council hereby resolves:


1. All individuals within the town limits are encouraged to wear face coverings while inside enclosed retail or commercial establishments;
2. All retail or commercial establishments should encourage staff who are interacting with the public where social distancing (6 feet) cannot be maintained, to wear face coverings;
3. Businesses are encouraged to post appropriate signage to inform the public of this resolution. Signs should be in plain, easy to understand language at entry points and in plain view of the customer;
4. All recreation participants and spectators are encouraged to practice social distancing and wear face coverings during town recreation sponsored practices, games and events;
5. Face coverings are worn to protect and to help prevent the spread of COVID 19;
6. There is increasing evidence that cloth face coverings help prevent people who have COVID-19 from spreading the virus to others.




